To Qualify you must meet one of the following criteria and provide required documentation:

- *Separating Active duty within 180 days with a DD2648 completed
- *Active duty spouse or a dependent of an active duty member 17 years old or older
- *Florida Resident Veteran or Spouse of a Florida Resident Veteran
- *You are a child of a Veteran and are a Florida Resident over the age of 17

Building Trade Certificate: HBI- PACT is 4 weeks. The course objectives are to obtain an OSHA 10 Certificate, a Red Cross First Aid/CPR/AED certificate, and a Pre-Apprenticeship Certificate Training (PACT). The OSHA 10 does not require renewing but is recommended to do so after 5 years. The First Aid/CPR/AED certificate is good for 2 years. The PACT certificate is 25% classroom and 75% hands on training that covers building trades and building maintenance. The training gives an overview of the following trades: *Carpentry- which includes flooring, roofing, framing, trim, windows & doors, & siding *Electrical *Plumbing *Masonry *Painting *Landscaping *Construction math * tools and materials *and instructions in all matters of safety. These opportunities are provided by the Home Builders Institute.
