Our Institution has two branch campus locations in the Okaloosa Walton area with campus staff available to assist students. Our Institution also offers all programs via 100% distance learning so students who are unable to access one of our campuses can take the entirety of their program virtually. Distance learning options include traditional online classes as well as classes offered via live streaming. All students, regardless of class modality, have access to and support from our distinguished faculty members. Remote resources are offered to all students (i.e. virtual advising, tutoring, class attendance, faculty office hours, etc.). Additionally, ERAU operates a fully virtual library, which provides student access to online resources, and is able to mail texts to students around the country when a text is not available online.

The most effective way by which employment barriers are eliminated is by making training and education accessible to all. Our training program offers degrees, certificates and/or credentials to individuals looking to gain skills necessary to enter high demand fields that offer increase employability and/or earning capacity.
