# ***CSP Process***

---

- **STEP 1 – DETERMINE ELIGIBILITY**
  - **Airmen must be within 180 days of approved retirement or separation**
  - **Participation dependent on unit and mission requirements**



- **STEP 2 – EXPLORE OPPORTUNITIES**
  - **Talk with a Transition or Education Counselor**
  - **Visit National Job Fairs**
  - **Visit State or Local Employment Offices**
  - **Review the SkillBridge Website**
  - **Review the DoDI Vetting Websites**
  - **Contact the Local Chamber of Commerce**



# ***CSP Process***

---

- **STEP 3 – SECURE APPROVAL**
  - **Visit the Education Counselor to review CSP vetting and application processes**
  - **Initiate dialog with potential CSP provider and begin completing the CSP application**
  - **Initiate completed CSP application in AFVEC**
  - **CSP application is reviewed by the Education Center**
  - **CSP application/memorandum approved by Commander (automated)**



# ***CSP Process***

---

- **STEP 4 – BEGIN TRAINING**
  - **CSP start and end dates as approved in the CSP application/memorandum**
  - **CSP location is authorized place of duty**
  - **Unit is responsible for accountability**



# ***DoDI Criteria for Vetting***

---

**Program should meet at least one of the following criteria:**

- 1. Listed as approved by U.S. Department of Veteran Affairs**
- 2. Accredited by agency recognized by U.S. Department of Ed**
- 3. A certificate program accredited by American National Standards Institute (ANSI)**
- 4. Registered apprenticeship/pre-apprenticeship program that meet(s) Department of Labor's Office of Apprenticeship (DOL/OA)**



# ***DoDI Criteria for Vetting***

---

**Be a training program accredited by:**

- Council on Occupational Education (COE)**
- Federal Law Enforcement Training Accreditation (FLETA)**

**\*Additionally the organization must either:**

- a. Sponsor a registered apprenticeship program related to the training; or**
- b. Oversee the sponsorship of registered apprenticeship programs related to the training.**

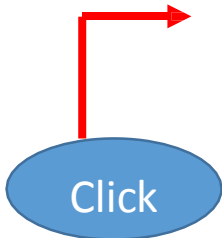

### Database of Accredited Programs and Institutions

The Department of Education is making available a searchable database of postsecondary institutions and programs accredited by accrediting agencies or state approval agencies recognized by the U.S. Secretary of Education. This database includes approximately 6,900 postsecondary educational institutions and programs.

The U.S. Secretary of Education recognizes those agencies determined to be reliable authorities as to the quality of education or training provided by the institutions of higher education and the higher education programs they accredit. Accreditation of an institution or program by a recognized accrediting agency provides a reasonable assurance of quality and acceptance by employers of diplomas and degrees.

The Department believes that the list will be a helpful tool for employers evaluating education credentials and for consumers making decisions about postsecondary institutions to attend. Consumers are encouraged to do additional research on institutions before making a selection of a school, checking, for example, on the transferability of credits between institutions, the availability of financial aid, etc.

The database does not include a number of postsecondary educational institutions and programs that elect not to seek accreditation but nevertheless may provide a quality postsecondary education. **The U.S. Department of Education recommends that the database be used as one source of qualitative information and that additional sources of qualitative information be consulted.**

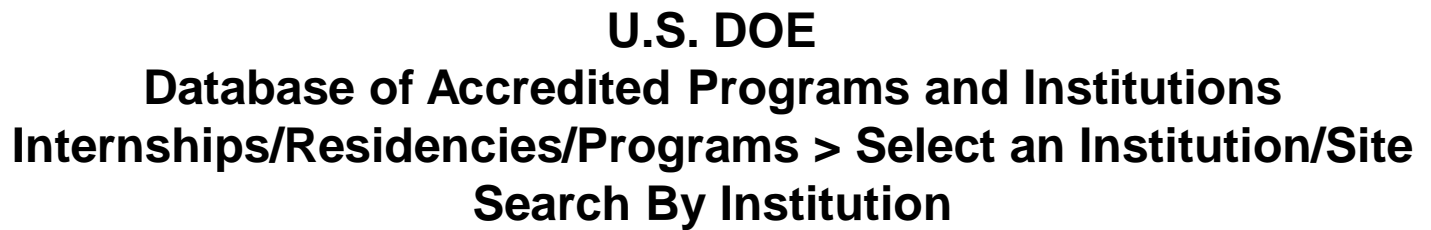

**What types of information can I access using this website?**  
This database contains information on accrediting agencies and the institutions, programs, internships, and residencies that they accredit.

**How do I conduct a search for a specific school?**  
On the Institution Search screen, enter the name of the school in the "Name of Institution" field and then click on the "Search" button or hit "Enter" on your keyboard.

**How do I search for an institution accredited by a specific accrediting agency?**  
Click on the gray "Search by Accrediting Agency" tab. Under the Current Agency Search heading, scroll through the Institutional Accrediting Agencies list or the Specialized or Programmatic Accrediting Agencies list to locate the agency name.
