The Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) is a federally funded employment and training program designed to build a skilled workforce that meets employer demand. Our program is designed to provide training opportunities in high demand occupations to increase employment, retention, and earnings of program participants.

Eligibility to Apply

- Must be a citizen or have the right to work in the U.S.
- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Must be registered for the Selective Service (males born after 12/31/1959)
- Must be an Okaloosa or Walton County Resident
