

# WORK SEARCH REQUIREMENTS

If you are a claimant and live in a county with 75,000 or more people, you must complete **5 work searches** or **1 CareerSource service appointment** per week. If you live in a county with less than 75,000 people, you must complete **3 work searches** or **1 CareerSource appointment**.

## WORK SEARCH CONTACT OPTIONS



Go to an employer's place of business and fill out a job application.



Sign up and use a career or job-market explorer, such as [EmployFlorida.com](http://EmployFlorida.com).



Apply for jobs through [EmployFlorida.com](http://EmployFlorida.com).



Complete an application for a job and send it to an employer.



Do work searches using job websites and industry publications.



Call employers to set up job interviews.
